Lancaster, W. S. West reign at Wildcat Relays

Redskins break two meet records

The **Lancaster** boys track team broke two meet records on its way to winning the Wildcat Relays for the fifth year in a row.

The 19th annual event drew 28 boys and 25 girls team and was held on a rainy Saturday at JFK.

The Redskins' 4x100 relay of Tony DiRienzo, Aaron Bapst, Chris Nelson and Mike Palma went a meet record 43.36. The same foursome broke the record in the 4x200 with a 1:29.62. The Redskins also won the shot put and discus relays with Gino Buono, Jon Luke Krywalski and Jake Miller competing on both.

Canisius was second followed by **Sweet Home**.

Clarence's John Inzinna won the open 1,600 meters in 4:24.69.

West Seneca West won the girls team title for the first time breaking a meet records along the way. **WilliamsvilleNorth** and **WilliamsvilleSouth** finished 2-3.

The Indians' Morgan Billi, Nicole Castilloux, Jillian O'Brien and Kelsey Randall won the 4x100 in a meet record 49.88.

The Indians also won the 4x200 and 4x800 relays. In the field events, Billi, Castilloux and Stacie Odrobina joined forces to win the long jump/triple jump in 65-2v.

The other meet record went to Williamsville South's foursome of Kailyn Arcury, Cassie Hyppolite, Kristina Arcury and Allie Van Buren in 1:02.31.

Nardin's Jill Shea won the 1,500 in 4:56.52.
