EA wins three races at Alden

East Aurora put on a comprehensive performance at Saturday's **Alden** Bulldog Stampede as it had two girls squads sweep the large *and* small school divisions while its boys team won the small school title.

EA's nationally- ranked girls squad was split in two for the contest, with Jenna Hulton (18: 13) leading the large school team to first place while Catherine Lusardi (17: 56) paced the small school team.

Scott Anderson (16: 10) and Alex Weberg (16: 47) finished 1- 2 for the boys. Joe Whelan of **Hamburg** won the large school race in 15: 47.

Lockport stars in Manhattan

Senior Kelsey Fraser placed third for **Lockport** in the girls A race at the 35th Manhattan Invitational at Van Cortlandt Park in the Bronx. Fraser finished the 2.5 miles course in 15: 14 running with the race's leaders for the first two miles. The winning time was 15: 03.

The **Clarence** boys placed seventh out of 46 teams. The Red Devils' top finisher was John Inzina in 13: 23. In the D race involving 40 teams, **Lockport's** Drew Perilli was 8th in 12: 54. Zack Ball of **Kenmore East** also crossed in 8th place in the G race in 13: 04.
