



## **HS ROUNDUP (March 1): Several locals qualify for state indoor track meet**

Several indoor track athletes from Lockport and Niagara Falls high schools qualified Saturday for next weekend's state indoor track meet at Cornell University.

Four Lockport Lions, including last fall's Section VI large school cross country champions Drew Perilli and Kelsey Fraser, and Niagara Falls long-jumpers Rodney Joyner and Ben Archie, all qualified for the state meet at Saturday's qualifier at Fredonia State College.

Fraser, a senior, won the 1,000 in 3:02.92, while Perilli, just a sophomore, won the 3,200 in 9:51.99.

Also qualifying for states from Lockport were senior pole vaulter Becky Fabbiano, who leaped 9-3 in the pole vault for second place. Also second from the Lady Lions was senior shot-putter Erin Miller, who had an outstanding toss of 38-feet, three inches.

Lockport senior Mary Rachel Robins was third in the 1,500 (5:05.54) and will compete in the state Intersectional Medley Relay.

Niagara Falls' Joyner was a double state qualifier, placing second in the triple jump (43-3) and taking first in the long jump with a leap of 22-feet, 3-inches.

Archie took second, jumping 21-5.

The Wolverines' boys 800 relay took fourth in 1:41.1,

The state indoor finals will begin at 9 a.m. for the girls and 2 p.m. for the boys.
