## Gordon doubles at Southern Tier Invitational

*Sweet Home sprinter nears Section VI mark*

Wayne Gordon has found his stride. The Sweet Home junior was a double winner Saturday at the Southern Tier Track and Field Invitational at Cornell University in Ithaca.

Gordon won the 55-meter dash in 6.58 and came from lane eight to win the 300 in 36.75. The Section VI record in the 55 is 6.54, held since 1974 by another Sweet Home standout, Joe Palmeri.

"All year long I know for a fact the Western New York record is kind of in the back of his mind," said coach Brian Lombardo. "He got into his pace and trusted himself to compete and that's all we're looking for this time of year."

Four girls took home first-place medals. Kailyn Arcury of Williamsville South won the 55 hurdles in 8.27 and Kala Allen of Williamsville East was the winner of the 600 in 1:40.88. In the field events, Rebecca Hildebrand of West Seneca West won the shot put in 34 feet, 8.50 inches and Sweet Home's Stephanie Izard cleared 5-foot-6 in the high jump.

Clarence's best finish was a second place by Megan Kaser in the pole vault, who cleared 11-feet.
