Truppo a triple-winner

Kelly Truppo was a triple-winner at the 27th WNY Girls Track Classic at Lancaster. The UB-bound Alden senior won the pole vault clearing 11 feet, 6 inches, the long jump in 16 feet and the triple in 34-9 3/4. Kailyn Arcury of Williamsville South was named track events MVP, and Lauren Hudson of Williamsville North was the field events MVP.

Arcury won the 100 hurdles in 15.07 and was runner-up in the 100 in 12.91. Hudson, a freshman, cleared 5-feet to win the high jump.

The host Redskins had a big meet as freshman McKenzie Kuehlewind won the shot put, adding to her Section VI best of 39-1.

Other Lancaster firsts were sophomore Lauren Sullivan in the 100 (12.84), seventh-grader Ashley Grazen in the 200 (26.68) and Sullivan, Corinne McCarthy, Grazen and Tiffany Cycon in the 400 relay (50.99). Favorites Kala Allen of Williamsville East (400), Sarah Loud of Williamsville North (400 hurdles) and Meghan Manley of Orchard Park (800) all won.
