Kozlowski wins event at Lancaster Invite

LANCASTER - Several Dunkirk runners had strong performances in the Lancaster Invitational on Friday.

In the 600-meter run, Jeremy Kozlowski finished first with a time of 1:38.5 and led the 4x400 relay team to a third-place finish along with Ken Dill, Edwin Gomez and Zach Meadows. The four-some finished in just 4:15.8.

In the 50m hurdles, Calvin Stallworth ran to a third-place finish with a time of 7.7. He was also fourth in the 300m (42.5).

In the pole vault, Tyler Gajewski placed second with a leap of 8-feet-6 inches.

The 4x200 relay team, consisting of Ramal Ready, Tyler Crumb, Mike McNiff and Zach Jankowski, took fourth, crossing the finish line in 1:58.9.

For the girls, Erica Santiago heaved the shot put 24-2 to take sixth place. In the 600, Amanda Michalski took sixth in 2:09.7 and in the 50m dash, Lisa Dunbar crossed the finish line in 7.6 to take sixth place.

The Marauders return to action next Saturday when they compete in the RIT Invitational.
