



## Dunkirk girls reach new heights in Indoor track

It was an exciting day for the Dunkirk girl's indoor track team as they saw a number of personal bests, a couple of school records and a sectional qualifying time.

Hailey Griewisch's sixth place finish in the 50 meter hurdles was just 0.02 seconds away from a sectional qualifying time.

"Lancaster has a facility that typically doesn't result in great times, distances, or heights," Dunkirk Coach A.J. Burnside said. "We had several personal bests, a few school records broken, and a sectional qualifier."

However, it was good enough to break her personal best and own school record of :09.2, with a time of :09.06.

In the same event the Lady Marauders saw another personal best time fall as Tania Shaver finished in tenth place with a time of :09.16

In the 600 meter, Calan Pogorzelski finished in third place with a time of 1:52.

Pogorzelski was also a part of Dunkirk's 4x400 relay team that finished in fifth place with a time of 4:52.

Also on the team was Amanda Michalski, Luisa Bonilla and Lisa Dunbar.

Dunbar finished tied for seventh place in the pole vault with a height of 7'6" which is a personal best. The height of 7'6" also ties Pam Waclawski's school record and qualified Dunbar for sectionals.

"We are very happy with how well the team is performing," Burnside said. "We're ready for next weeks championships at Fredonia, and looking forward to sectionals in three weeks."

In boy's indoor track action Dunkirk's Calvin Stallworth took home first place honors in the high jump with a leap of 6-0.

Stallworth also earned a second place spot with a distance of 39-4 in the triple jump.

The Marauders also had another second place finisher in Alex Gonzalez who did so in the 1,000 meter. Gonzalez finished with a time of 2:49.1.

Gonzalez was also a part of the second place finishing 4x400 relay team for Dunkirk with a time of 4:06.6. Other members of the team included Jeremy Kozlowski, Ken Dill and Zach Meder.

One other notable finish for the Marauders was Tyler Gajewski who came in fourth place in the 50 meter hurdles with a time of :07.6.
