



## Gowanda takes first at non-league meet

SILVER CREEK - The Gowanda Panthers had a strong day preparing for the County Meet as both the boys' and girls' team won Monday in a Section 6 non-league meet.

In the boys' race, Gowanda's Kevin Brown took first with a time of 15:47 in the 2.7-mile course. Teammate Chris Kruszka placed second with a time of 15:59 while Christian Igielinski placed fourth with a time of 16:31. Silver Creek's Jarrid Ringer placed fifth at 16:32 followed by Gowanda's Taylor Nielson (16:33) and Jared Bogardus (16:56). Gowanda's Dakota Quinn placed 10th with a time of 17:09. Also for the Black Knights, Shane Carline placed 11th (17:14), Jack Capitano (15th, 17:43), Adam Tanner (16th, 17:48) and Sam Parker (18th, 17:54).

The Panthers took first place with 20 points followed by Frewsburg 65, Silver Creek 65, Sherman 79 and Ripley 136.

"They were very exciting races," Silver Creek coach Mike Janish said. "Everyone ran hard for a non-league meet just a few days before the County Meet. Basically, it was a good day to get speed work in and the kids ran very hard."

In the girls' race, Gowanda had 32 points followed by Sherman 50, Silver Creek 65, Frewsburg 74 and Ripley was incomplete.

The Lady Panthers' Emily Steves placed second with a time of 18:02 while Silver Creek's Hannah Seiders took third place, crossing the finish line in 19:08. Gowanda's Eryka Krusiowski placed fifth with a time of 20:15 followed by teammate Katie Stang at 20:22. Also for Gowanda, Sarah Grubbs took ninth with a time of 20:52 followed by teammate Laura Wing at 20:58.

Also for Silver Creek, Trisha Pflueger took 11th at 21:21 while Sarah Adams was 15th at 22:08. Lauren Johengen took 17th at 22:36 and Beth Kehrer finished 20th at 23:00.
