Randolph Claims Div. 2 Titles; Falconer, MG Girls Prevail

RANDOLPH - Host Randolph won both Division 2 girls and boys, Falconer claimed Division 1 girls and Maple Grove took Division 3 girls as the Chautauqua-Cattaraugus Athletic Association Track and Field Championships concluded two days of competition at Randolph Central School on Saturday.

Randolph took Division 2 girls with 138 points with Salamanca second at 106 and Frewsburg third at 95. The Cardinals also won the Division 2 boys with 195 points compared to Frewsburg with 81 and Cattaraugus-Little Valley with 80.

Falconer was the runaway winner in Division 1 girls with 171 points followed by Allegany-Limestone with 147 and Southwestern with 70.

Maple Grove captured the Division 3 girls title with 156 points with Portville second with 108 and Clymer next with 96.



Olean was first in Division 1 boys with 147 points while Falconer was second with 78 and Fredonia third with 75.

Portville won the Division 3 boys crown with 202 points followed by Maple Grove with 118 and Chautauqua Lake with 70.

Individually, Randolph had wins from McKenna Maycock in the 400 meters (59.69), Brenna McDonald in the pole vault (9-6), Dane Dechow in the 110 hurdles (16.001) and Anthony Schwartz in the 400 (51.64). The Cardinals also had several second-place finishes in winning the girls and boys titles from Division 2.

Falconer was outstanding with Shannon Murphy winning the 2,000 steeplechase (7:42.07), and all three of its relays came across in first place in Division 1 girls competition.

The 400 relay team won in 50.29 and the 1,600 relay in 4:12.81 and the 3,200 relay in 9:47.30. Leanne Johnson, Mary Strand, Makalia Haveron and Amasharay McDonald formed the 1,600 relay and Johnson, Murphy, Katie Saff and Kirsten Holmberg the 3,200 relay.

Corri Hannon of Falconer was runnerup with a throw of 31 feet, 11 inches in the shot. Sam Stayer of Allegany-Limestone won the event with a toss of 33-6

The Golden Falcons' boys 1,600 relay team of Nate Sharp, David Olson, Mike Saff and James Haveron came in first with a 3:36.18.

Caroline Benson led Maple Grove to the Division 3 title with a 5:08.71 clocking in the 1,500 as she got past teammate Megan Marsh, who had a 5:09.71.

Christina Walter, also of Maple Grove, chipped in as she took the 100 with a 12.95.

John Strickland of Panama claimed the high jump (6-2) and Trey North of Westfield took the long jump with a leap of 20-8.

Tyler Cassidy of Fredonia won the 1,600 with a 4:41.52 while Zachary Jackson of Randolph was second with a 4:43.56.

Dylan Cassidy of Fredonia took the 400 hurdles with a 57.08 followed by Christian Igielinski of Gowanda at 58.20.
