

Falconer Relay Sets School Mark

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CALEDONIA - Falconer's 400-meter relay team set a school record while placing third in Division 2 during the first day of competition at the New York State Public High School Athletic Association Track & Field Championships at Caledonia-Mumford High School on Friday.

The quartet of Makalia Haveron, Amasharay McDonald, Hannah Courtney and Mary Strand set a new mark of 49.44, erasing the previous record of

49.45 set at the Chautauqua-Cattaraugus Athletic Association Championships.

Leeanne Johnson, McDonald, Strand and Haveron were 10th with a 4:07.57 in the 1,600 relay for Falconer.

Corri Hannon of Falconer finished 11th in the discus with a toss of 98 feet, 5 inches.

Christina Walter of Maple Grove was seventh in the 200 preliminaries with a 26.55 and was 18th in the preliminaries with a 12.68 in the 100.

Travis Nagle of Randolph is 15th in the pentathlon with 1,809 points. He had a 17.23 in the 110 hurdles for 600 points, a 5-10 in the high jump for 610 points and a 38-11 in the shot put for 599 points.

He will attempt to better his placing today.

Also, McKenna Maycock of Randolph finished 10th in the 400 with 59.29.

Jennie Thies of Southwestern wound up ninth in the triple jump with a 35-7.

Only Walter, Nagle and Thies competes again today.

Several area athletes were scheduled to complete today. They are Maple Grove's 3,200 relay team of Caroline Benson, Katelyn Benson, Hope Pietrocarlo and Megan Marsh; Thies in the high jump; Shannon Murphy of Falconer in the 2,000 steeplechase; John Strickland of Panama in the high jump; Dylan Cassidy of Fredonia in the 400 hurdles; and Eddie Marshall of Dunkirk in the high jump.

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
