

Delgado Shines at Invite

CUBA - Brandon Delgado placed first with a time of 17:33.2 as Jamestown took second place behind Bradford in the Large School Division boys race at the Cuba-Rushford Invitational on Saturday.

Zachary Fellows was seventh, Thomas Liuzzo eighth, Michael Capestrani ninth, Jordan Johnson 10th, Joseph Walsh 15th and Jake Petrucello 16th for the Red Raiders.

The girls were incomplete in the Large School Division race.

Alexandra Perkins was 10th, Sarah Casel 12th, Ashley Taylor 13th and Elizabeth Mazzone 22nd.

The Frewsburg boys with Zach Stahlsmith finishing sixth in 18:47 and Nik Holsinger ending up ninth with a 19:14 wound up second in the Small Schools with 57 points.

Iroquois, Pa., was the winner with 40 points while Allegany-Limestone was third with 60 points. Jon Chapin of Canisteo-Greenwood won the race with a 17:34.

Other personal bests for the Bears were Steve Swart 12th with a 19:43, Chris Sardi 22nd with a 20:19, Chaz Ormond 23rd with a 20:27, Blake Rhodes 29th with a 20:55, Ian McFarland 36th with a 21:42, Jacob Frangione with a 21:42, Ben Rosario with a 22:07, Collin Dziubinski with a 22:20 and Drake Marsh with a 22:55.

The Frewsburg girls wound up third out of five complete squads and 11 schools overall with 67 points. Allegany-Limestone won with 47 points and Smethport followed with 67.

Chelsea Smith ran fifth over the flat and dry 3.1-mile course with a 22:25 while Shannon Hodgkin was eighth with a 23:12.

Tracy Woodring of Smethport paced the field with a time of 20:56.

Running personal bests for Frewsburg were Maggie Smith 14th with a 23:51, Morgan Knight 19th with a 25, Shannon Cantrell 24th with a 26:53 and Dana Weber 27th with a 27:57.

ALDEN - Freshman Kirsten Holmberg won her second race with a time of 19:23 over the 3.1-mile course as Falconer came in second with 60 points in the Small Schools Division race at the Alden Invitational.

Holmberg had won her previous race at the McQuaid Invitational earlier this season.

Shannon Murphy finished third with a 20:02 and junior teammate Katie Saff fifth with a 20:18 for Falconer. Rounding out the scoring for the Lady Golden Falcons were Jessie Caprino 20th with a 21:47 and Allison Sanderson with a 22:32.
