

Frewsburg Boys, Girls Runners Pick Up Victories

The Frewsburg boys put four runners in the top 10 to defeat Silver Creek, Southwestern and Franklinville in the last league meet of the CCAA cross country season.

Nik Holsinger (first), Zach Stahlsmith (third), Steve Swart (sixth) and Chaz Ormond (10th) led the way for the Bears (9-6) on the three-mile course at the Jamestown Audubon Sanctuary. Paul Armstrong paced Southwestern (6-8) with a second-place finish, and Jarred Ringer led Silver Creek (5-9) with a fourth-place finish.

Frewsburg finished with 34 points, Silver Creek 53, Southwestern 55 and Franklinville 86.

In the girls race, Frewsburg (6-8) edged Southwestern (5-9), 27-28. Silver Creek and Franklinville were incomplete.

The Black Knights' Hannah Seiders, a seventh-grader, was first, followed by Chelsea Smith of Frewsburg and Andrea O'Boyle of Southwestern.
