Barker's Scheving wins state title

Barker junior Tyler Scheving broke Barker and Niagara-Orleans League records in the 800-meter run and won the New York State Division II championship Friday in Caledonia with a time of one minute, 54.31 seconds.

Kenmore West's Marcus Lobdell placed third in the pentathlon Saturday with a score of 3,280. His best effort came in the high jump, where he cleared six feet, four inches, second best among the pentathletes. He was fifth in the 110 hurdles (15.71), fifth in the long jump (20-03 3/4), ninth in the shot put (37-03 1/4), and 17th in the 1,500 (4:56.82).

Starpoint's Jake Wray finished fourth overall in the 110 hurdles with a time of 14.80. Earlier on Saturday, Wray broke his own Starpoint record with a time of 14.45 and placed third in the Division I finals.

Lockport's Alex Reid finished fifth overall in the long jump with a distance of 21-11 1/4.

Grand Island's Alex Brown tied for eighth in the high jump with a mark of 5-04.

Starpoint's Bernice Dumbleton was eighth in the discus with a throw of 111-03. On Friday, she came in fifth in Division I with a distance of 118-2. Lockport's Keeley Raylea was 10th with a mark of 93-11.

Niagara Falls' Brandon Joyce tied for ninth in the high jump by clearing 6-03.

Niagara Falls' Cordell Johnson placed ninth in Division I in the 400 with a time of 49.70. Tonawanda's Bobby Liebel came in 11th in the Division II race with a time of 51.67.
