Frannies, Sweet Home have good day at RIT

St. Francis and Sweet Home track and field athletes had successful days at the Tiger Invitational Meet at the Rochester Institute of Technology.

The Red Raiders' relay team of Andy Hayes, Alex Schaffstall, Pete Tremblay and Derrick Weyrough won the 1,600 in 3:34.07. The St. Francis 3,200 relay of Hayes, Schaffstall, Ian Pacholic and Kerrick Woysner was second in a school-record time of 8:26.65. Hayes also broke the St. Francis record by running 1:25.62 in the 600 as he finished second.

Wayne Gordon of Sweet Home set a school record in the 300-meter dash, breaking his own mark of 36.22 with a second-place time of 35.82. Gordon also was second in the 55 meters.

In the girls competition, Sweet Home's Stephanie Izard won the high jump at 5-4 while Kayleigh Timko of the Panthers won the shot put with a toss of 33-4. Mikayla Pearce of Maryvale won the triple jump in 38-3.
