Gordon paces Sweet Home track; Clarence girls edge Lancaster



Wayne Gordon was a triple winner, while Tyvon Rivers earned first- and second-place points to help Sweet Home capture the boys Section VI large school team title with 92 points. Gordon won the 55 meters (6.51 seconds), the 300 (36.9) and was a member of the Panthers' triumphant 4x200 relay.

The foursome of Jeff Hart, Gordon, Jordan Johnson and Derell Hennings won in 1:37.6 to edge runner-up Jamestown by nine-tenths of a second.

Kalen Sullivan of West Seneca West won the 1,000 and 1,600.

Amherst won the small school boys title with 80 points as Jailyn Twitty captured the triple jump (45 feet, 5 inches) and the long jump (22-11). Teammate Brandon Borden finished the 55 hurdles in 7.83 to take the small-school crown in that event.

The Clarence girls edged Lancaster by two points to take the large school title, carried by their depth in running events. Kaitlin McCadden won the 3,000 and 1,500 races, leading a 1-2 finish with Katelyn Tresino in the latter event that proved to be the difference. McCadden also helped the 3,200 relay team triumph.

Kala Allen of Williamsville East tuned up for Thursday's Section VI State Qualifying Meet by winning the 55-, 300- and 600-meter races. Sweet Home's Stephanie Izard won the hurdles and long jump.

Williamsville South took the small school Section VI crown as Kailyn Arcury won the hurdles and 55-meter dash and took second in the long jump, and teammate Carolyn Hopkins won the 1,000 and 1,500 and was a member of the winning 3,200 relay.

Maryvale's Mikayla Pearce won the long and triple jumps.
