### Sullivan sets pace at Beaver Island

Sullivan covered the 5K course in 16.58.0 to outkick a pair of Lockport runners, Mike Feeney and Zack Chenez. Lang went 20:24.2 to edge teammate Jessica Monzyk. Lockport won both the boys and girls Division I team titles.

In the Division II races, the Hutch-Tech boys and the Grand Island girls placed first. Tech took the top two places thanks to Rhace Colon (17:11.6) and Jammarr Chandler (18:13.6). Emma Sullivan of Mount St. Mary crossed first in 20:45.0. Grand Island's top two runners were close behind as Megan Karpie and Ellen Lutnick were 2-3.

The boys Division III race was won by Nichols with an impressive five runners in the top 10. Nick Sheen led the Vikings with his third-place finish in 18:26.5. City Honors' Seamus Degan won the race clocking a 17:17.2. Claire Attea's 21:41.8 helped Immaculata win the Division III race in 21:41.8.
