Hutch-Tech boys sweep city cross country titles

City Honors takes overall girls title while Tech wins final meet

Undefeated in dual meets this season and the winner in Thursday's championships, Hutch-Tech took the overall team title in boys cross country at the Buffalo All High Championships.

The Engineers won the championship meet with 26 points, besting City Honors, which took second with 38 points.

Seamus Degan of City Honors won the individual title at the championship meet, running the 2.5-mile course at the Rose Garden in Delaware Park in 13:30. Rhace Colon of Hutch-Tech took second (13:47) while Jamarr Chandler of Hutch-Tech was third (13:58).

On the girls side, Hutch-Tech won the All-High Meet but City Honors won the overall championship after going undefeated in dual meets and taking second to the Engineers in the final meet.

Verketa Barcero of Hutch-Tech took the girls individual title with a time of 17:10. Teammate Jenna Rossi was second (17:28) while Zoey Binder of City Honors was third (17:36).
