

## **Reyda, Szukala Show The Way At Dunkirk**

DUNKIRK - Led by Lauren Reyda and Josh Szukala, the Fredonia girls and boys cross country teams each took first place in the Dunkirk Invitational on Saturday.

Reyda, the sixth-ranked girls runner in Class C, finished the 3.1-mile course in 20:37.78 - nearly a full minute faster than her teammate and second-place finisher Michaela Tramuta (21:34.08) - to help the Lady Hillbillies win with 22 points, followed by Immaculata with 43, Silver Creek with 71, Holy Angels with 108 and Dunkirk, which was incomplete.

Along with Reyda and Tramuta, Fredonia's Meredith Zebracki was third (22:39.40), Jillian Kowalski seventh (23:59.43) and Maitland Langworthy eighth (24:00.18).

For Silver Creek, Hannah Seiders was third after finishing the race in 22:14.34.

The boys team was the winner with 22 points, defeating St. Francis (35 points) and Dunkirk (85 points).

Behind Szukala, Chaz Mancino was third with a time of 19:19.24, Alex Crise fifth (19:39.11), Mark Dudek sixth (20:04.65), Jacob Brown seventh (20:14.05) and Alex Glasier 10th (20:48.08).
