

## **JHS Indoor Track Teams Shine**

FREDONIA - The Jamestown boys and girls indoor track teams were very impressive at Fredonia State on Saturday.

David Morse was first in the pole vault with a height of 11-feet-6 and was sixth in the 55 with a 7.31.

Dylan Gaeta had a personal best with a 2:52.1 while finishing fourth in the 1,000 and Awsten Beaver was sixth in the pole vault with a 7-6.

Michael Capestrani was second with a 5:05 and Patrick Walsh was fifth with a 5:15.9 in the 1,600.

Gaeta, Capestrani, Walsh and Zachery Barnes placed fourth with a 9:37.6 in the 3,200 relay.

The girls had an outstanding meet with Cienna Simon (9.11) finishing second and Olivia Sinatra third (8-0) in the 55 hurdles.

Shelby Adams took second in the pole vault with the tie-breaker of 8-0 and Sinatra also was third in the pole vault with an 8-0, but lost out to teammate Adams. Adams was also sixth in the triple jump (28-4).

Olivia Zabrodsky was third and qualified for the sectionals with a time of 3:19.8 in the 1,000.

Kylie Wilson took the 300 and 55 with sectional-qualifying times of 44.4 and 7.67.

Leah Holt was third in the 300 (46.6) and Maria Liuzzo fifth (46.9).

Brielle Edborg was third in the high jump (4-8) and the 800 relay team of Sinatra, Megan Oelbracht, Stephanie Benson and Sarah Gibson had the same position with a 1:59.5.

The 3,200 relay team of Zabrodsky, Haley Kulakowski, Alexandria Perkins and Rachel Johnson came in third with a 11:26.6.

Gibson, Liuzzo, Oelbracht and Benson was fourth with a 5:08.8 in the 1,600 relay.

Perkins was fifth with a 5:55.5 and Megan Vail sixth with a 6:01.4 in the 1,500 while Patricia Keller was sixth in the shot put with a 25-11.
