Lancaster wins Wildcat Relays

The **Lancaster** boys and **West Seneca East** girls celebrated titles Saturday at the 18th annual Depew Wildcat Track and Field Relays.

It was the fourth title in a row for the Redskins, who won the 400, 800, shot put, discus and pole vault relays to finish with 82 points. West Seneca East's first girls title came after it won the distance medley relay, sprint medley relay and the 400 relay to score 79 points.

Day-long winds kept meet records and personal records to a minimum. **St. Francis** was credited with the only record at the meet as its long jump/triple jump relay of Darryl Overton, Eric Kurzdoreu and Andy Gordon went 79 feet, 9z inches.

- The **West Seneca West** girls defended their title at the Batavia Invitational. West broke four meet records while winning nine events. Record breaking performances were turned in by Morgan Billi in the long jump (18-5.5), Nichole Castilloux in the 200 (25.5), Jillian O'Brien in the 100 and the Indians' 4x100 relay of Amanda Major, Castilloux, O'Brien and Kelsey Randall (50.1).

- Rob Golabek of **Frontier** earned MVP honors while breaking the meet record in the shot put (57-7) at the His and Hers Invitational at Victor.
