## Cross country Sectionals

The **East Aurora** girls had all seven runners finish in the top 10 to highlight performances Friday at the Section VI Cross Country Championships held over a snow-covered course at Long Point State Park along Chautauqua Lake.

"It was winter down there, no question about it," said Clarence coach Trevor White. "The snow wasn't as deep on the trails because of the trees. It wasn't ideal, but I think the best teams won."

**Clarence, Kenmore East, Fredonia, Wilson and Franklinville** won boy's teams' titles. Joining EA as girls team winners were **West Seneca West, Starpoint, Franklinville and Randolph**.

Senior Ryan O'Connor of East Aurora had the fastest time of the day among boys, covering 3.1 miles in 16:36.4; Junior Catherine Lussardi of East Aurora ran the fastest time among girls in 19:14.8. Teammate Jenna Hulton was runner-up in 19:22.0.

The top team, along with the next five individuals not on the winning team, qualified for the New York State Championships next Saturday at IX-Warwick Valley High School.
