Athletes on the Depew boys track and field team won the 110-meter shuttle hurdles at the 18th Annual Wildcat Relays on Saturday at Depew High School.

Juniors Mike Wilkowski and Joe Weselak and seniors Mike Sanders and Chris Jones finished with a time of one minute, 10.41 seconds, as Jones completed the final run with a 16.4-second performance.

The Wildcats finished fourth overall with a score of 40.5.

In track and field action this weekend, Depew, John F. Kennedy and Maryvale will participate in the 2nd Annual Starpoint Track Classic on Saturday, beginning at 8 a.m.
