Cleveland Hill's Peoples headed back to sectionals

One year after helping Cleveland Hill's 4x100-meter relay team win the New York State High School Public High School Athletic Association championship, senior Raymond Peoples is edging closer to making a return visit to states.

At last weekend's 50th Annual Erie County Interscholastic Conference Championships at Alden High School, Peoples easily won the 100-meter dash with a time of 11.24 seconds, also garnering the top spot in the 200-meter run with a time of 22.27 seconds.

Peoples is coming off a week in which he also ran an ECIC-record time of 21.7 seconds in the 200-meter dash at the Little 4 Championships at John F. Kennedy High School.

Also, Eagles teammate Kevin Washington finished second and is headed to the Section VI championships in the 110-meter high hurdles, thanks to a 15.93-second performance.

On the girls' side, the Cheektowaga Central 4x1,600 relay team is headed to sectionals after placing third in the ECIC event with a time of four minutes, 15.14 seconds.

Depew's Kristen Angierski won the triple jump event with a leap of 34 feet, 7.5 inches.
